Prayer to the One God of the Universe (Numerous references)

The need for ablution (4:43; 5:6)  $\checkmark$ Support for ritual washing (Bathing - Leviticus 15:11; Hand washing Psalms 26:6)

Followers of the previous scripture to observe their Qiblah and the Believers (Mu'mins) their own

Oiblah (2:145) ✓

Appropriate garments (7:31) ✓

Allusion of times: (4:103; 11:114; 17:78; 24:58; 30:18; 2:238: 20:58)

Prayers must be observed on time (4:103) ✓

Prayer involves prostration (Sujood - 4:102; 48:29) 

There is more than one prayer (Prayer in plural used - Salawat) (2:238) 

There is a general form to prayer (2:238-39) 

Standing position (3:39; 4:102) 

Bowing down and prostrating (4:102; 22:26; 38:24; 48:29) 

A warning not to abandon prayer as was done by people before (19:58-59) but to establish prayer (Numerous references) 

The purpose of prayer - To remember God alone (6:162; 20:14) 

Prayer involves utterance (4:43) 

The purpose to protect from sins (29:45) 

A moderate tone of prayer (17:110)
